

Abstract Submission Guidelines for the NARA Scientific Sessions (NSS)

Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines when submitting abstracts:

Title

- Title: Maximum 100 characters: Font- Times New Roman, 14, bold
- Authors: List all authors, indicating the corresponding author with an asterisk
- Provide email addresses on separate lines. Font: Times New Roman, 12
- Author affiliations: Font- Times New Roman, 11, Italic
- Keywords: Include up to 5 keywords

Abstract

- Word Limit: Abstract should not exceed 300 words
- Content: The abstract should encompass a succinct summary of the research, covering objectives, methodology, results, discussion, and conclusions
- Formatting: Font-Times New Roman, 12; Line spacing-1.5

Authors are kindly reminded that abstracts that do not adhere to the aforementioned guidelines will not be considered for acceptance

Submission Process:

- Please submit a soft copy of the abstract in both .doc/.docx and PDF formats as attachments, along with the author information form, via email to nss2023@nara.ac.lk
- Email subject: Use “Scientific Session of NARA_2023”
- Deadline: Ensure that your abstract is submitted on or before the 16th of September 2023

Review and Communication:

- All submitted abstracts will undergo a peer review process
- The decisions regarding acceptance will be communicated to authors by the 6th of October 2023

Publication:

- Accepted abstracts will be featured in the Proceedings of the Scientific Session-2023
- Authors interested in publishing complete papers are invited to submit full papers to the journal of the National Aquatic Resources Research and Development Agency (NARA journal)
