Purpose:

These guidelines are issued to assist authors in preparing abstracts and extended abstracts for submission to the NARA Scientific Sessions. The extended abstract should provide a concise summary of your research work, including its objectives, methodology, results, and significance.

Guidelines for Abstract

General Instructions for Abstract

• **Word limit:** Maximum **300 words** (excluding title, author details, keywords, and references).

• Language: English

• Font: Times New Roman, size 12, single spacing

• Margins: 1 inch on all sides

• File format: Microsoft Word (.docx)

Abstract Structure

The abstract should include the following components in the order given below:

1. Title

- o Clear, concise, and reflective of the content
- o Font size 14, bold
- Center aligned

2. Author(s) and Affiliations

- o Full names of all authors
- o Institutional affiliations with addresses in Italic letters
- Indicate the corresponding author with an asterisk (*) and provide the email address

3. Body of the Abstract

 Abstract should have a short introduction, objectives, methodology, results, and a conclusion(s) written as a single paragraph.

4. Keywords

- o Up to 5 keywords
- Separated by commas

Additional Notes

- o Avoid tables, figures, and complex mathematical formulas.
- o Ensure clarity, accuracy, and scientific rigour.
- o Abstracts not complying with the word limit and format may be rejected without review.

o Plagiarism will result in immediate rejection.

Guidelines for Extended Abstract

General Instructions for Extended Abstract

• **Page limit:** Maximum four (04) pages

• Language: English

• Font: Times New Roman, size 12, single spacing

• Margins: 1 inch on all sides

• File format: Microsoft Word (.docx)

1. Introduction

- o Brief background and rationale for the study
- o Clearly state the research problem and objectives

2. Methodology

- o A short description of the methods and materials used
- o Emphasize innovative or unique techniques

3. Results and Discussion

- o Key findings of the research, supported by data if available
- o Interpretation of results and comparison with existing work

4. Conclusion

- o Major conclusion(s) and potential implications
- o Future directions, if applicable

5. References

o Use APA 7 referencing style consistently

- Submit the abstract, Extended Abstract, and duly filled author information form via the official session email or submission portal as indicated in the call for papers (narascientificsessions2025@gmail.com)
- o Deadline: 4th September 2025
